A) BY TRIMESTER:

- Before July 20, 2026: **711,50€** (59€ registration fee + 652,50€ 1st half of 1st trimester)
- Before September 27, 2026: **652,50€** (2nd half of 1st trimester)
- During the first 10 days of December 2026: **1.305€** (2nd trimester)
- During the first 10 days of March 2027: **1.305€** (3rd trimester)

B) ENTIRE COURSE (7% discount):

Total **3.699,95€** (3.640,95€ + 59€ registration fee).

- 1st payment before July 20, 2026: **711,50€** (59€ registration fee + 652,50€ 1st half of 1st trimester)
- 2nd payment before September 27, 2026: **2988,45€** (rest of the course)

**Students who attend the group classes regularly can join any regular extra classes outside the program for a fee of 2€ per hour.*

GENERAL RULES

- Students are expected to maintain the school's facilities and leave the space clean and tidy after use.
- Smoking is prohibited.
- Eating inside the classroom is discouraged and prohibited during the classes. You will always have some minutes between classes to rest and eat if necessary.
- For safety reasons, it is recommended not to wear jewelry, watches, or earrings during class.
- In the classroom:
 - Be respectful to the teachers and your classmates.
 - Focus on the material being taught and shared. The classroom is not an appropriate setting for unrelated social interactions.
 - If you are arriving late, ask permission to enter the room and join the class.
 - Wear the appropriate shoes or socks for class.
 - We recommend that you bring a towel and a water bottle.
 - We recommend that you keep your valuables with you.
- The use of mobile phones or electronic devices during classes is prohibited, except when authorized by the teacher to record exercises or choreographies.
- Liability:
 - The school is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of personal belongings.
 - The school is not liable for any injuries sustained on its premises.
- All students must have their valid medical insurance.
- Missed Classes:
 - Students cannot retake missed classes for reasons beyond the school's control. Classes will only be rescheduled if the teacher is unavailable and the school cannot provide a substitute.
 - All absences should be communicated to the school's coordination.
 - The certificate of conclusion will only be awarded to students who achieve a minimum attendance rate of 80% in all the disciplines.
- The Professional Training Program must be paid according to the terms outlined in the registration form.
- If a student wishes to withdraw from the program, they must notify the school in writing. Failure to do so will result in the student being required to pay for the regular trimester.
- Non-EU Students:
 - Students from outside the European Union are advised to ensure their medical insurance is up to date.
 - Let us know as early as possible if you need any further assistance with the immigration and visa procedures.
- The school reserves the right of admission.
- All students entering the country on a student visa must attend at least 80% of the program's classes. Failure to comply with this rule may result in the suspension of the visa and/or its non-renewal for the next academic term.
