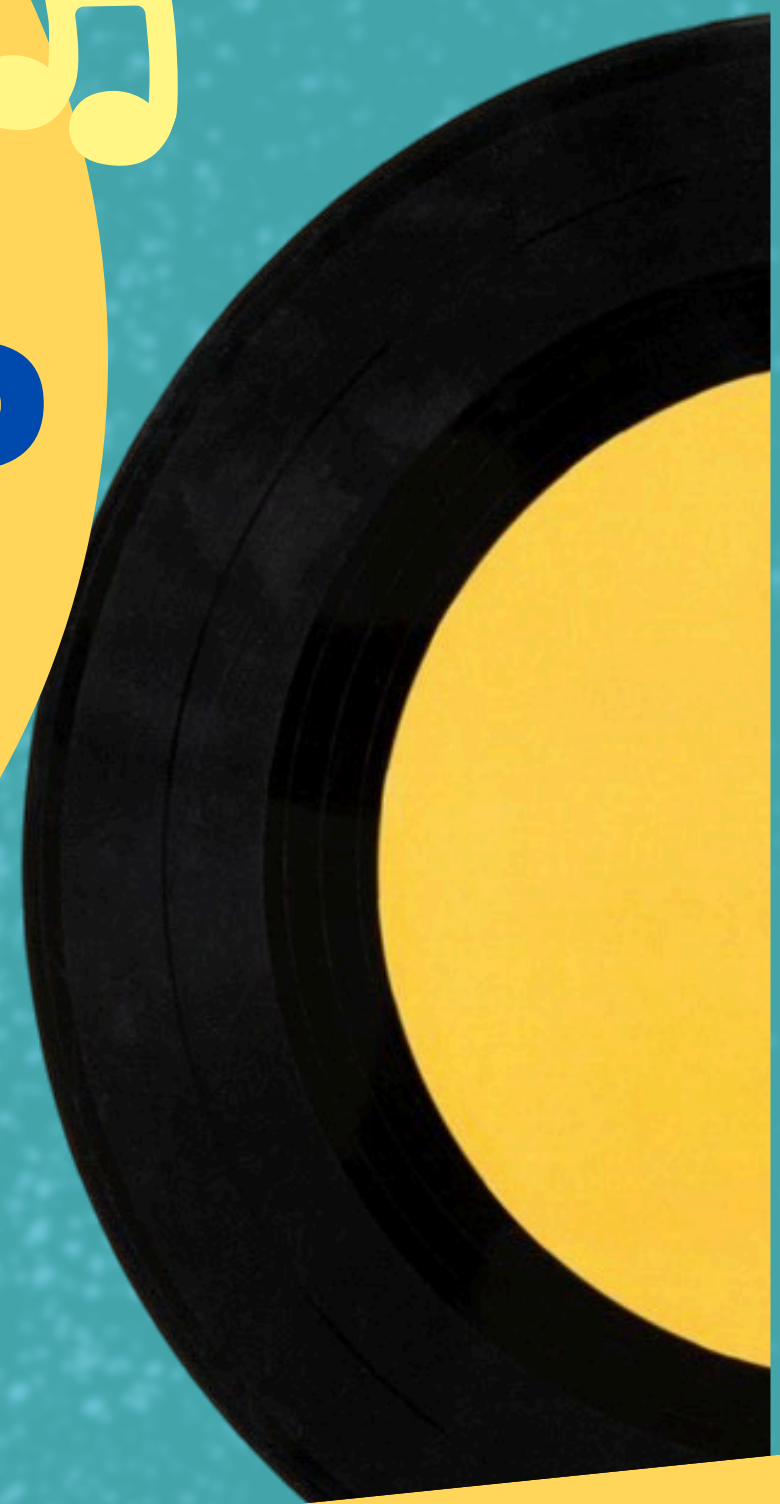

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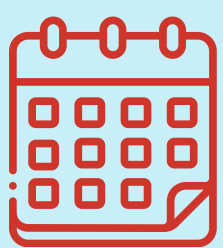
WHO ARE WE?

The Luthier School of Music was founded in 1979 by Alicia Alcalay, a classical guitar graduate. In 2011, she and her son, the professional dancer Guillem Alonso, launched a new project by establishing a dance department. This department was founded with the aim of becoming a centre of excellence specialising in tap dance. The department also offers specialisations in classical dance, jazz, contemporary dance, body percussion, urban dance, Irish dance, Baroque dance and music for dancers.

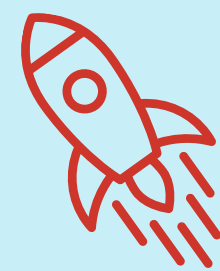
The school has also been organising a children's arts camp for many years, where instructors specialising in music, dance and theatre share their knowledge with the children in a playful way, fostering learning across various disciplines. Due to continued growth in participation, this year sees the introduction of an intensive programme for young people. Each week, participants will explore a different artistic discipline through dance, music, film, theatre and visual arts, guided by specialist professionals.

Each week we will cover a different topic



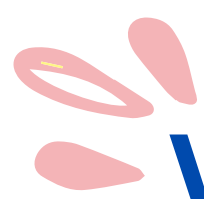
We'll work on a project together.

WEEK 1

MUSICAL THEATRE

June 29 - July 3

The first project will be to produce a musical. We will work on the songs, choreography and scenes, and take it a step further by designing the costumes and sets. With the help of Bealia Guerra, an actress, dancer and choreographer who has worked on musicals such as Chicago, Tootsie, Grease and Fame, we'll explore different musicals and learn about the rehearsal process and life backstage. You'll have the opportunity to ask any questions you have to gain an insight into what it's like to perform in a musical.



WEEK 2

CINEMA

July 6 - 10

Lights, camera, action!

This week, we're going to make a short film! We'll experience the entire process from start to finish, beginning with writing the script. Then we'll discover what it's like to act and dance in front of the camera. Then we'll record the voices and create the soundtrack. We'll also be joined by Violeta Madel, a 17-year-old actress who has starred in the Disney Channel series Ayla y los Mirror and 3Cat's Yo nunca nunca, among others. She will share her first-hand experience of professional film shoots and the casting process, and answer any questions our participants may have.



WEEK 3

AFRICA

July 13 - 17

It's going to be the most rhythmic week! We'll be discovering Africa through its music and dance. We'll combine African percussion and dance, and learn about life on the continent, its traditions and customs, and its culture from people who live there. Above all, we'll explore its music! We'll also draw inspiration from The Lion King musical to create animal puppets with a professional puppeteer and explore their movements. Hakuna Matata!
